Please join us for tea and coffee in the church hall after the service!

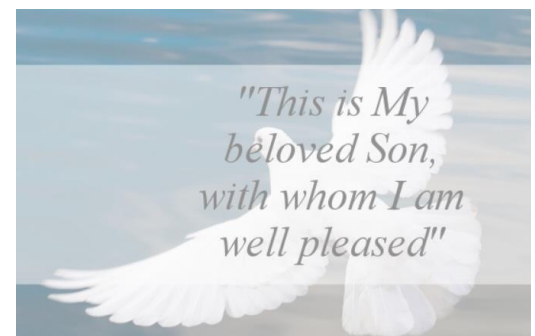

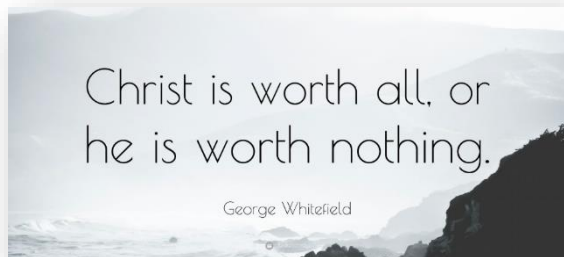

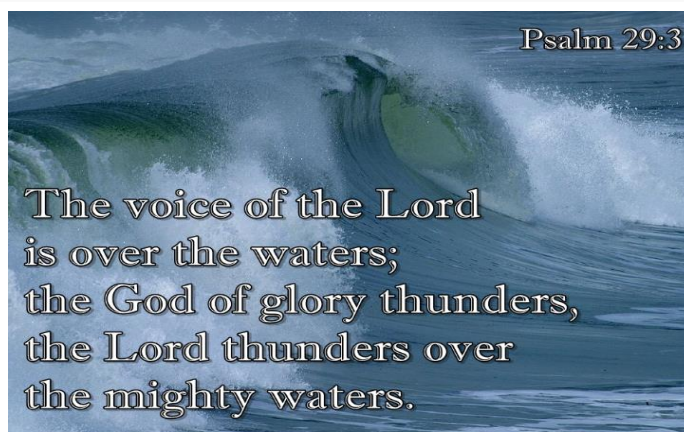
